THE UNITED STATES ATTORNEY CHARGES:

COUNT ONE

[18 U.S.C. §§7(3) & 13 and T.P.C. § 42.092(b)(3)]

On or about December 16, 2008, at the Fort Hood Military Reservation, Western District of Texas, a place within the special maritime and territorial jurisdiction of the United States, the Defendant

MISTY S. SANFORD

did intentionally, knowingly or recklessly fail unreasonably to provide necessary food, water, care, or shelter for an animal in the person's custody, in violation of Texas Penal Code Section 42.092(b)(3) and Title 18, United States Code, Sections 7(3) and 13.

COUNT TWO

[18 U.S.C. §§7(3) & 13 and T.P.C. § 42.092(b)(4)]

On or about December 16, 2008, at the Fort Hood Military Reservation, Western District of Texas, a place within the special maritime and territorial jurisdiction of the United States, the Defendant

MISTY S. SANFORD

did intentionally, knowingly or recklessly abandon unreasonably an animal in the person's custody, in violation Texas Penal Code Section 42.092(b)(4) and Title 18, United States Code, Sections 7(3) and 13.

COUNT THREE  
[18 U.S.C. §§7(3), 13 and 1382]

On or about December 16, 2008, at the Fort Hood Military Reservation, Western District of Texas, a place within the special maritime and territorial jurisdiction of the United States, the Defendant

MISTY S. SANFORD

did go upon a military reservation for a purpose prohibited by law or lawful regulation, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 7(3), 13 and 1382.


COUNT FOUR  
[18 U.S.C. §§7(3) & 13 and Tex. Health & Safety Code § 826.032(a)(1)]

On or about December 16, 2008, at the Fort Hood Military Reservation, Western District of Texas, a place within the special maritime and territorial jurisdiction of the United States, the Defendant

MISTY S. SANFORD

did fail or refuse to register or present for registration each dog owned by the person, in violation of Texas Health and Safety Code Section 826.032(a)(1) and Title 18, United States Code, Sections 7(3) and 13.

OFFENSES & MAXIMUM PUNISHMENT

Count One: 18 U.S.C. §§7(3) & 13 and T.P.C. § 42.092(b)(3) – Cruelty to Animals – One year confinement; \$4000 fine; One Year TSR; \$25 SA.

Count Two: 18 U.S.C. §§7(3) & 13 and T.P.C. § 42.092(b)(4) – Cruelty to Animals – One year confinement; \$4000 fine; One Year TSR; \$25 SA.

Count Three: 18 U.S.C. §§7(3), 13 and 1382 – Unlawful Entry – Six months confinement; \$5,000 fine; \$10 SA.

Count Four: 18 U.S.C. §§7(3) & 13 and Tex. Health & Safety Code § 826.032(a)(1) – Failure to Register Pets – \$500 fine; \$5 SA.
